

Enterprise Recon Feature Deprecation Notice, March 2023

We have some exciting updates coming to Enterprise Recon this year. However, as we continue to bring new features and extend support for more platforms and data types, we will be retiring support for some end-of-life systems in upcoming releases.

The following software and platforms will be removed from Enterprise Recon in version 2.9.0 (expected June 2023):

- UNIX Server AIX 6.1 — UNIX Server AIX 6.1 has been end-of-life since 2017. Enterprise Recon will continue to support UNIX Server AIX 7.1 and later.

The following software and platforms will be removed from Enterprise Recon in version 2.10.0 (expected October 2023):

- [Linux 2.4 Node Agent](#) — Linux 2.4 Node Agent has been end-of-life since 2011. Enterprise Recon will continue to support Linux 2.6 Node Agent and later.
- Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2 64-bit — Windows Server 2008 R2 64-bit has been end-of-life since 2020. Enterprise Recon will continue to support Windows Server 2012/2012 R2 64-bit and later.
- macOS Mojave 10.14 — macOS 10.14 has been end-of-life since 2021. Enterprise Recon will continue to support macOS Catalina 10.15 and later.
- Exchange Domain Exchange Server 2010 – Exchange Server 2010 has been end-of-life since 2020. Enterprise Recon will continue to support Exchange Server 2013 and later.
- Microsoft SQL Server 2008 – SQL Server 2008 has been end-of-life since 2019. Enterprise Recon will continue to support SQL Server 2012 and later.

We recognize that the limited notice of some of these changes may impact some of our customers. Wherever possible, we will provide extended notice of such changes in future.
