

Deprecation Notice Card Recon Supported Platforms

As we continue to develop Card Recon and bring new features and extend support for more platforms, we will be retiring support for some end-of-life systems in our upcoming release.

The following software and platforms will be removed from Card Recon in version 3.0.2 (expected May 2024):
