

Feature Deprecation Notice | Enterprise Recon 2.11

May 2024

As we continue to develop Enterprise Recon and bring new features and extend support for more platforms and data types, we will be retiring support for some end-of-life systems in upcoming releases.

The following software and platforms will be removed from Enterprise Recon in version 2.11.0 (expected June 2024):
